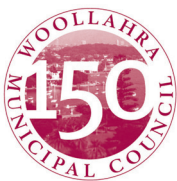


CENTRAL COAST: DESIGNING NEW SPACES FOR ARTS PRACTICE

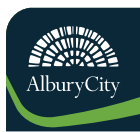
NAROOMA: LIBRARIES – SAFE HAVENS AND HOT HOUSES FOR CULTURAL EXCHANGE
